How to earn your badge:

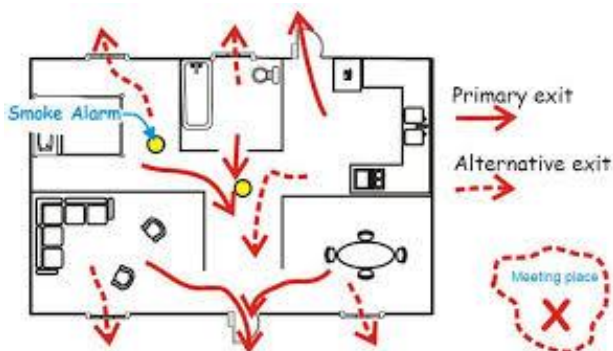


2. Say what you should do if a stranger walks over to you and tries to talk to you.
