Where else could you make an emergency call if the public telephone wasn't working?

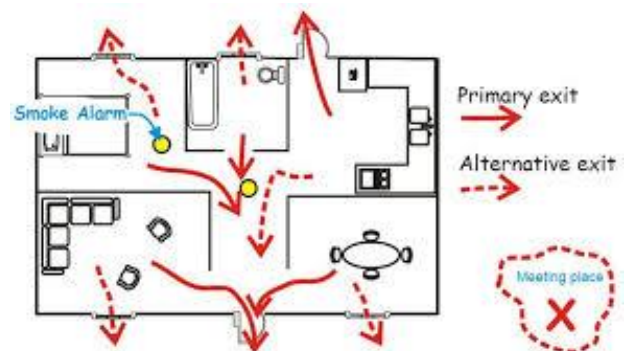


5. Make a list of useful emergency numbers.
